Policy: (Supersedes C4 - Limited English Proficiency Students)

It is the policy of the Caledonia Central Supervisory Union (CCSU) and its member Districts to ensure that English Learners aged 3-21, including immigrant students, have equitable access to academic and extracurricular school programming as required by law.

Implementation:

The superintendent or the superintendent's designee shall be responsible for developing and implementing procedures to comply with federal and state laws, which define standards for serving students who are English learners.
